Definite and Indefinite Articles

ادوات النكرة والمعرفة

Definite and Indefinite Articles are a type of determiner used in the English Language to specify the noun they accompany .

The Definite article refer to a specific noun. The Definite article in English is "the "it is used when referring to a particular noun that already known or has been previously mentioned.

1- "the" is used with both countable and uncountable nouns. is used before singular and plural nouns. It is used when referring to a specific noun that the speaker and the listener are familiar with or have discussed before.

" the " is used before unique noun, such as names of oceans, rivers, mountains, and famous landmarks.

e.g- The specific ocean is the largest ocean in the world . (referring to a specific ocean)

" the " can also be used before certain

e.g –I climbed Mount Everest . (referring a specific mountain)

e.g-The cat is sitting on the mat .(refer to a specific cat and specific mat)

e.g-I saw the movie last night . (refer to a specific movie)

e.g The children are playing in the park .(refer to a specific children)

e.g- The water in the bottle is cold . (refer to a specific amount of water)

e.g the girl \rightarrow the girls
```

e.g –the sugar / the milk / the money

*When superlative or ordinal numbers are used before a noun , the definite article " the " is typically used .

e.g – She is the tallest girls in the class .

e.g-He is the first person to arrive.

*Use in specific contexts

Certain expressions and contexts have specific article usage

e.g –In the morning . (referring to a specific time of day)

e.g - At the weekend . (referring to a specific time period)

st The indefinite article refers to a non-specific noun . The indefinite article in English are " a" and " an " . They are used when referring to a non-specific noun or when introducing a noun for the first time . They are used in front of singular countable noun .

The indefinites article are not used with unique nouns

2- $^{\prime\prime}$ A $^{\prime\prime}$ is used before words that begin with a consonant sound . It is used with only with singular countable nouns .

```
e.g-I saw a car parked outside.
      e.g – She has a pen.
   3- "An" is used before words that begin with a vowel sound.

      e.g- She is an excellent singer. (referring to specific singer)
      e.g-I need an umbrella. (referring to specific umbrella)
*Omission of articles
Articles are not used with proper nouns (names of people, places, etc.)
e.g-John is my friend . ( no article before the proper noun " John " )
e.g-London is a beautiful city .( refer to a specific refer to a specific noun " London ")
Articles are not used with plural nouns or non-countable nouns when refer to a specific
referring to them in a general sense.
e.g-Dog are loval animals. (no article before the plural noun)
Articles are also omitted in some sixed expressions.
e.g - " By day " . ( no article before " day " )
e.g -" in bed ".( no article before " bed ")

*Zero Article

In some cases, no article is used before a noun. This can occur with certain types of nouns, such as abstract nouns, languages, meals, and sports.

```
e.g-Love is universal language . ( no article before the abstract noun " love " )e.g-I speak English . ( no article before the language " English " )
```

It is important to note that there are exceptions and special cases when it comes to articles in English .Additionally , the usage of articles can be influenced by regional or dialect variations . To strengthen your understanding and usage of articles , it's helpful to read and listen to English in various contexts and engage in regular practice .
