Plural nouns

1- Most nouns add **-s** in the plural.

doctor → doctor**s**

book → book**s**

student → student**s**

2- Nouns that end in **-s, -ss, -sh, or -ch** add **-es**.

bus → bus**es**

class → class**es**

sandwich → sandwich**es**

3- Some nouns that end in -y change to -ies.

city → cities

country → countries

dictionary → dictionaries

family → families

4- Some nouns are irregular.

man → men

woman → women

child → children
